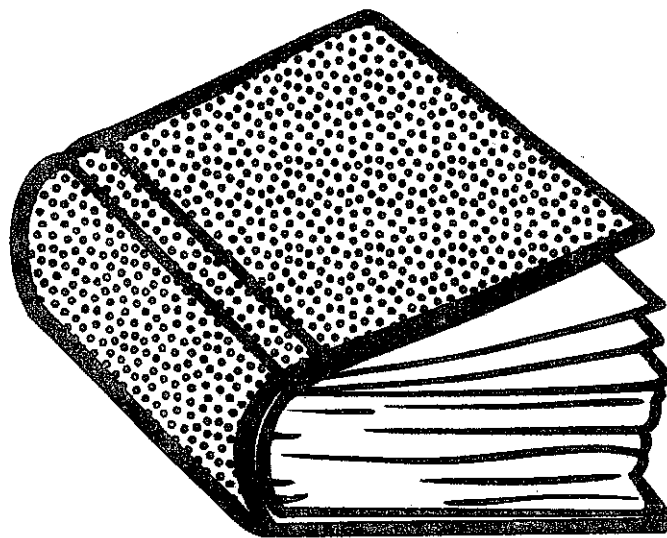


Summer Reading for Incoming 1st Graders
